Attention Landowners! Are you a new or existing forest landowner wishing to know more about your trees from tree identification to improvement techniques within your forest? Each spring Virginia Cooperative Extension offers one-day short courses on management options for forestland in Southside Virginia and this year for the first time we will focus on **Tree Identification – Where it All Begins!** This will be a precursor to forest health to include an update on invasive plants and insects and a short field trip after lunch.
